

Author's Guidelines for Abstract

- The abstract must be written in British English language and an informative synopsis/summary of the research work.
- Font type: Times New Roman
- Size of the font
 - Title: 14 point
 - Authors list: 12 point
 - Affiliations: 10.5 point
 - Corresponding author's email: 10.5 point
 - The main text of abstract: 12 point
 - Keywords: 12 point
- Single-line spacing and justified alignment. Margins for left, right, top and bottom should be 2.54 cm (1 inch).
- All abstracts should follow the structured format; with the subheadings of Introduction, Methods, Results and Conclusion. Bold the subheadings.
- The word count should not exceed 300 words.
- The full term for which an abbreviation or acronym stands should precede its first use unless it is a standard unit of measurement.
- Do not include references in the abstract.
- Provide a maximum of 5 keywords that will assist in the cross-indexing of the article.
